**'Best' award (1,3) in terms of safety for the Storchenmühle Twin 0+ infant carrier with Isofix Base**

**Marktleugast / Germany, June 2007 – Of all child seat models tested, the Storchenmühle Twin 0+ with Isofix Base excels with the best result for front and side impact, as well as for the safety of the seat structure.**



For the main test with Stiftung Warentest, the ADAC and other automobile associations and consumer organisations from many European countries a new generation of test dummies, called Q-dummies, were used this year. The reason for the change from the original P-dummy to the Q-dummy was, according to Stiftung Warentest, that the Q-generation is more flexible and a closer match to the equivalent age human. The main decision is based on 50% safety, with a strong emphasis placed on side impact protection, and 50% of the test is based on handling and comfort.

The Storchenmühle Twin 0+ infant carrier, which has an identical construction to the RECARO Young Profi plus was tested together with the Isofix base. The Isofix base is connected directly to the car body with Isofix anchoring and therefore the danger of misuse through the seat not being fitted correctly is eliminated.

After the 'safety' test criteria, where the Storchenmühle Twin 0+ scored 'best' with the result 1,3 the 'handling and comfort' criteria for was evaluated in equal parts.

The positive test result of the Storchenmühle Twin 0+ is due to the unique adjustable backrest. The backrest of the infant carrier can be optimally adjusted to the height of the baby. This allows the child to be transported rearward facing safely for as long as possible.

In conclusion the Storchenmühle Twin 0+ achieved the test result 1,7 with a "good" overall rating.

About the company:

The history of the company Storchenmuehle began in 1949. The company was named after the restaurant in which the couple, Irmgard and Hans-Joachim Kauffmann, first decided they would sew fittings for prams, shortly afterwards followed the production of baby clothes. A very special milestone was the first worldwide child safety seat Nicki, which celebrated its premiere in Germany in 1963. In 1979 Storchenmuehle started producing wooden highchairs and playpens in the newly built wood plant.

Today, in the Competence Centre Child Safety in Markleugast, Germany approximately 120 people are employed producing child safety seats for children from birth to 12 years, as well wooden high chairs from German beech.
